The Flishinghurst site is a little way down Chalk Lane (A turning to the left between the Willesley roundabout and the Peacock pub on the road to Goudhurst – A262) postcode TN17 2QB. The gates say Flishinghurst Woodyard.

I have a few days available when I am not working over the forthcoming two weeks and would be eternally grateful for anyone who could rock up for an hour or two between 10 and 1 (or whenever anyone is free), and wield a paint brush or a hammer. It will be simple stuff so bring the family (but not in their party clothes).



Ensemble Male and female - these appear in many of the songs,

Many of the drag queen vocals can be lip synced, some can be sung, depending on casting.

#### **MUSICAL NUMBERS**

Most numbers are group songs - if the drag queens are singing, they are usually accompanied by the 3 divas who are major players.

There is lots more work for the ensemble in the stage show than in the film and this is the main draw for the cast.
