Voting:

All members over 18 have one vote. Junior Members are welcome to attend, but cannot vote or be elected onto the Committee. In accordance with our Constitution a quorum of five members or one tenth of the membership, whichever is greater, must attend the AGM for voting to take place and ratification of the Executive Committee.

Standing for Committee:

All CODS Members may nominate themselves for election to the Executive Committee, but this must be made in writing and emailed to the CODS Secretary at (Cods.secretary@gmail.com) for receipt by the 11th April, 2023.

The Vice Chair will automatically assume the role of Chair for two years, unless they choose not to assume the automatic role of Chair at the next AGM. In which case, the Vice Chair must notify the current Chair and Executive Committee at the start of their term in accepting the role of Vice. This will enable the Executive to select a new Chair from within the existing Executive Committee. The Chair's role should be ratified by CODS Membership.

Trustees:

The Trustees must be ratified at the AGM, as they formally retire and must be re elected by the Charity (Membership).



SYNOPSIS

Based on the 2010 film of the same name, Made in Dagenham is drawn from the real-life 1968 sewing machinists strike at the Ford factory in Dagenham, Essex which was influential in the passing of the Equal Pay Act of 1970.

The musical focuses on the leader of the strike, Rita O'Grady, as she encourages the women of the Ford factory to walk out after they are re-classified as unskilled workers, while their male counterparts see their wages increase.

After Rita is patronized and snubbed at a union meeting, the women's grievances over their worker status turn into a fight for equal pay. Determined not to be treated like the poor relation, the women vote unanimously to strike and encourage the women at the Liverpool factory to strike also. However, when the American bosses fly in and lay off 5,000 men as a result, including Rita's husband Eddie, cracks begin to show in the women's solidarity.

Risking her marriage and friendships, Rita continues her efforts for equality and gives a rousing speech at the Trade Union Conference, leading to the passing of equal pay within the union. As Eddie finally recognizes his wife's achievements, the women celebrate their life-changing success.
